Labor Day – No Worship


Please note: the church office will be closed and there will be no worship service on Labor Day, Monday, September 2nd.

Beverly Mann passed away on July 31. Her funeral service was on Aug. 9 with Rev. Thomas Schmitt officiating.


Baptism
