That He delivers that justification through the Means of Grace (Baptism, preaching, the Word of God, and Holy Communion). And to give you those Means of Grace, He gives pastors and teachers, etc. So that literally everything that we have and everything that we are, in this life and the next, is an inexpressible gift from God. For that we give thanks.

As we enter this sacred season of Lent let us give thanks for all that God provides for us each and every day, but rededicate ourselves to those things that he gives us that lead to our eternal days.


# WINTER WEATHER
